

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SQA Results Overview

Work Experience

All Senior Phase pupils will be entitled to five days of work experience during the current school session per year. Due to SQA examinations we would encourage them to organise it between October 2022 and March 2023. These days can be consecutive or roll across the session depending on the nature of the work placement. If your child is keen to organise a work experience and has approval from a particular organisation, company and/or employer then we ask them to complete the form and return to Miss Griffiths asap.

Attendance

Over the past two years, average school attendance has fallen at Largs Academy. This is particularly true in the Senior Phase. In an effort to encourage better attendance, all school functions and excursions will only be open to young people with 90% attendance or above. There may be exceptional circumstances where a young person's attendance has fallen below this figure for health or personal reasons. This may be taken into consideration when reviewing attendance. However, for the vast majority of pupils, 90% attendance or higher will be required in order for pupils to attend events like the S6 Leaver Day and Prom / school trips.
