

SQA Results Overview

- Over 1750 (+150) SQA qualifications achieved.
- 90% of S4 achieved 1 or more N5s and 50% achieved 5 or more. (All in line with last session)
- 65% of S5s least 1 Higher with 20% achieving 5 or more. This rises to 75% achieving 1 level 6 qualification and 29% achieving 5 level 6s when wider qualifications are included.
- 24% of S6 achieved an Advanced Higher with 33% achieving a level 7.
- We have submitted 125 appeals to the SQA on behalf of pupils or staff. The outcome of these will not be known until October 2023.
