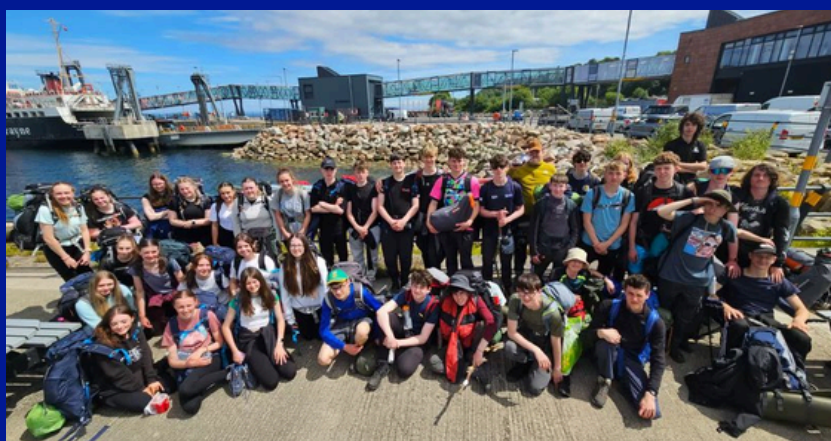
“Grease” is the word...
